

With an underwater viewer you can see what is going on under the surface of your pond.

You will need:

- a large tin or plastic tube
- a piece of transparent plastic or polythene
- a rubber band
- waterproof sticky tape or masking tape

1. Remove the top and bottom of the tin with a tin opener. Carefully hammer down any sharp pieces.
2. Cover the top and bottom rims with tape to cover any sharp edges.
3. Cover one end with transparent plastic and fix it in place with a rubber band.
4. Gently push the plastic-covered end of the viewer just below the surface of the water in the pond and see what is happening underwater.
5. For best results use your viewer on a bright, sunny day.
6. Do not stand where you will cast a shadow as you will frighten away the animals you want to look at.

REMEMBER: ONLY USE THE VIEWER IN SHALLOW, SAFE POND EDGES.
